Baselining your P6 Projects on a Consistent Basis is a Mandatory Step at Many Companies

But how do you ensure that your Project Managers and Schedulers are creating weekly and/or monthly baselines?

The Answer is P6ETL® for Auto Baselining

Overview

P6ETL® for Auto Baselining (P6ETL®) is a software utility that automatically creates daily, weekly, and/or monthly baselines in your P6 database for all or just a subset of your P6 projects.

P6ETL® is a Windows console application that runs on a Windows workstation, VM, or Server. Using the Windows Task Scheduler, P6ETL® users can schedule jobs to create baselines for any regular interval and at any time of day, week, or month.

Features

Automatic

Once the jobs are set up, P6ETL® will create the baselines without any manual intervention.

• Setup Unlimited Number of Jobs

Each job creates baselines for 1 or more projects.

P6ETL® users can setup an unlimited number of jobs to create baselines using a variety of regular intervals and filters. For example, the following jobs can be setup at your company:

- Job 1 Create weekly baselines on every Monday at 6am with a Baseline Type of **Weekly Status Baseline** for all Projects assigned a Project Code of **Weekly Baseline**.
- Job 2 Create daily baselines at 10pm every day with a Baseline Type of **Daily Update** for all Projects assigned a Project Code of **Daily Turnaround Baseline**.
- Job 3 Create monthly baselines on the first Tuesday of every month at 1am with a Baseline Type of **Monthly Status Update** for all Projects assigned a Project Code of **Monthly Baseline**.

• Email Notifications

P6 users can be notified a few days before P6ETL $^{\$}$ creates the baselines. P6ETL $^{\$}$ can notify P6 users based on the OBS, the Project Owner, and/or specific email addresses.

In addition, email notifications can be sent immediately before and immediately after the baseline is created.

Requirements

Windows Workstation, VM or Server

The computer does not need to be a dedicated computer for P6ETL® but the computer should be running 24/7. Detail requirements are provided along with a quote.

• P6 Web Services

Your P6 environment must be running P6 SOAP Web Services. Web Services are a standard component for the enterprise version of P6.
